The family membership includes spouse and all legal dependent children age 17 or younger. Extended family members, regardless if they reside at the same address, cannot be added to the family membership offering. Exceptions are permitted for adult dependents with special needs. Exceptions are also considered for single young adult offspring without dependents.

The spouse designation can be substituted for a babysitter add-on at time of signup at no additional cost. Children under the age of 15 cannot be present without a babysitter or adult guardian.



PER PERSON MEMBERSHIP COST

Paid prior to February 1st: \$460

Membership offered per person, 3 years of age or older.

For children age 14 and younger, an adult membership, senior add-on, or babysitter add-on must be purchased as well. Children under the age of 15 cannot be present without a babysitter or adult guardian. Memberships are non-transferable.

ADD-ONS TO MEMBERSHIP:

Please note that add-ons cannot host guests and cannot be shared to other accounts.

BABYSITTER ADD-ON:

\$260

Can be used for one person, 17 years or older per day. The babysitter cannot be on the premises without the child member present. This pass can only be designated once per day. It can be a different person each day.

SENIOR ADD-ON:

\$360

Age 60 and older. Add-on available to family and per person memberships. Limit two add-ons. The senior add-on may come independently of the primary member but cannot host guests.

Splash pool pavilion 1:

\$70 booking fee, 30 non-member guest maximum.

Splash pool pavilion 2:

\$70 booking fee, 30 non-member guest maximum.

Central pool small pavilion:

\$60 booking fee, 25 non-member guest maximum.

Lake grove pavilion:

\$50 booking fee, 20 non-member guest maximum.

Costs:

Booking fee plus guest fee per non member guest. All non member attendees age 3 and older are subject to the guest fee, regardless of the use of swimming facilities. Guest tab due before 8pm on day of party.

Policies:

Lake Kandle will only conduct business with MEMBERS and will not deal with 3rd parties. GUESTS may not be on Lake Kandle property at any time without the host member present. Members may not combine events or share guests across accounts. Member host must provide gate staff with a guest list upon arrival.

Cancellation:

The booking fee is non-refundable but if the host can cancel reservation before 11AM the day of the party they will receive booking fee as account credit. Cancellation rescinds permission for additional guests.

Four Week Stress-Free Swim Training Program

July 6th- August 1st

Registration and fees will become available in May

Training Tiers taught at Central Pool

- Swimming 101: Intermediate Swim Lessons and Stroke Development (Ages 5-8)
- Intro to Competitive Swimming (Ages 7-12)
- Competitive Swim Training (Ages 12-17)

Have your kids become better swimmers, learn stroke mechanics, and the essential fundamentals needed to become competitive swimmers!

Entry into competitive swimming can be intimidating but we've designed a program that is laid back, requires no fund raising or volunteer work, and is friendly to your summer vacation schedule.

The program runs for 4 weeks, 5x a week, on weekday mornings before the central pool opens to all patrons. Participants are not required to come to every practice session. Don't stress! Come as often as it fits into your family's schedule.



Swim Lessons For Non-Swimmers (TYPICAL AGES 3-8)

Fee Per Six Lesson Series: \$215

Students must be members. Payment due at registration. Lessons are non-refundable once class begins. Make up dates will only be scheduled for instructor cancelled classes. Use of the pools is limited to students only.

Six lessons are taught at a 4:1 student to instructor ratio. Lessons start at the Splash Pool but may also include using the lake for lake safety lessons and an introduction to the lake attractions.

The swim lesson program features an introduction to the water class (Level 1) and a beginner swim lesson class (Level 2).

For stroke development, please consider Lake Kandle's Swimming 101 training program or private lessons with one of our instructors.

Level 1

Introduction to Water Skills (typical ages 3-5)

Students will learn elementary aquatic skills such as submerging their face, blowing bubbles, explore swimming movements in the water (supported arm and leg action on front and back). Instructors will discuss water safety and may bring the class down to the lake to explore the lake kiddie attractions.

Level 2

Fundamental Aquatic Skills (typical ages 4-8)

Students will learn to float without support on the front and back and will practice recovering to a vertical position. They will practice submerging their head in a rhythmic pattern. Students will also practice gliding on their front and back, explore simultaneous arm and leg actions (front and back), roll over from front to back, and back to front.

Instructors will discuss water safety and may explore supervised deep water attractions in the lake if the class is ready.

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to participate in any way in the Lake Kandle, Inc facility activities SUCH AS BUT NOT LIMITED TO SWIMMING, DIVING, BOATING, RECREATIONAL SPORTS, OUTDOOR PLAY, EXERCISE, OUTDOOR LEISURE, PICNICKING, CLIMBING, USING A SWING, TRAVERSING MULTIPLE TERRAINS, LIFTING AND CARRYING OUTDOOR LEISURE SUPPLIES("Activity") I, for myself for personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

ACKNOWLEDGE, agree, and represent that I understand the nature of such activities and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity. I further agree and warrant that if at any time I believe conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.

FULLY UNDERSTAND THAT: (a) Lake Kandle, Inc ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS, AND DEATH ("RISKS"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions or inaction's, the actions or inaction's of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED ON THE REGISTRATION; (c) there may be OTHER RISK AND SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LOSSES either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY

FACILITY RULES

- SWIMMING NOT PERMITTED UNLESS A LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY.
- CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 12 SHOULD BE SUPERVISED WITHIN ARMS REACH WHEN IN OR AROUND THE WATER.
- PARENTS MUST PROVIDE DIRECT ADULT SUPERVISION FOR THEIR CHILDREN. LIFEGUARDS ARE NOT BABYSITTERS.
- POSSESSING OR BEING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF RECREATIONAL DRUGS OR INTOXICATING SUBSTANCES IS PROHIBITED. SMOKING AND VAPING ARE PROHIBITED EXCEPT IN MARKED DESIGNATED AREAS.
- OBSERVE ALL POSTED SIGNAGE AND OBEY THE STAFF WHEN THEY ENFORCE RULES.
- FAILURE OF A STAFF MEMBER TO INSIST UPON COMPLIANCE WITH A RULE SHALL NOT CONSTITUTE A WAIVER FROM OBEYING A RULE. THE RULES MUST BE OBEYED.
- FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH RULES CAN RESULT IN SUSPENSION OR LOSS OF MEMBERSHIP WITHOUT REFUND.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

Lake Kandle is a family oriented facility and must provide a safe work environment for their employees. No member of staff should be required or feel obliged to deal with any patron either face to face, over the phone or in correspondence, who is exhibiting threatening, abusive or violent behavior. Such behavior is defined as, but not limited to threats of violence to members of staff, sexist, racist or homophobic remarks, intimidating language, screaming, swearing and/or aggressive body language.

LAKE RULES

1. Any person showing evidence of any communicable skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharges, or any other communicable disease shall be denied admission.
2. Any person with excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts, or bandages shall be denied admission.
3. Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any signs or symptoms of a gastrointestinal (stomach) disease in the past seven days.
4. All children in diapers must wear diapers specially designed for immersion in water (such as swimming diapers). Do not wash out soiled diapers in the bathing water.
5. Children should be encouraged to use the restroom before entering the water. Immediately report any "accidents" you observe in the bathing waters to a lifeguard.
6. No animals, except for service animals, shall be allowed on the beach, or in the lake.
7. Glass containers shall be prohibited in food and drink areas.
8. All persons shall shower before entering the water.
9. Conduct which endangers the safety and comfort of others shall be prohibited. No throwing sand or rocks!
10. Outdoor bathing shall be prohibited during an electrical storm.
11. Persons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol shall be prohibited from entering the water.
12. Children under the age of 12 should be supervised within arm's length by parent or adult caretaker in or around the water.
13. There shall be no swimming beneath the docks or diving boards.
14. There shall be only one person at a time on the rope swing and diving boards.
15. There shall be no running on the docks or engagement any type of activity that endangers the comfort or wellbeing of others.
16. There shall be no swimming outside the designated swim area.
17. Inner tubes, rafts, and other floatation devices are not permitted in the deep water or near the docks. Therefore, if your child cannot swim, they cannot be in deep water. Floats large enough for more than two adults are prohibited.
18. Lifeguards are not babysitters. Parents are responsible for the safety of their children.
19. Stand up paddle boards are not permitted on the lake. Oars are not permitted in the swimming area.
20. Management reserves the right to change or modify the rules at any time. Management reserves the right to modify hours of operation based upon staffing limitations, weather conditions, beach or dock maintenance, or low attendance.

BOAT RULES

1. **Personal boats are not permitted without a boat space rental agreement. Ask office employee for details.**
2. All passengers must wear a life jacket and remain seated. Rental boaters may only exit the boat at the boat rental dock.
3. There is no jumping or swimming from boats. Boats are not permitted in the swimming area.
4. Rental Boats must remain within sight of the office.
5. ALL boats must keep a safe distance from the spillway and maintain at least one boat length from other boats.
6. Boats are not permitted within the designated swimming area.
7. Lake Kandle is not responsible for the theft, loss, or damage to personal items. Make sure personal items are secured.
8. In the event of a storm, please dock the boat immediately and find insulated cover in a car or building.
9. Boaters are responsible for any damages made to Lake Kandle property.

OUTDOOR RECREATION RULES

1. Observe all state and federal laws concerning barbecuing, fishing, and biking.
2. Lake Kandle does not permit skateboarding, rollerblading, unregistered motorized vehicles (mopeds, atvs, powerwheels), or any other disruptive accessory. NO DRONES!
3. In the event of a thunderstorm, please return to your vehicle. Trees, pavilions, tents, and other open air shelters are not safe places of refuge.
4. Please be courteous to others and use designated open areas for sport and recreational activity.
5. Water balloons are prohibited.
6. Use proper receptacles for trash, recyclables, and refuse.
7. Please smoke or vape only in designated smoking areas with cigarette disposal bins (end of picnic grove & pool parking lots).
8. Lake Kandle is not responsible for the theft, loss, or damage to personal items.

RULES FOR THE POOLS

1. Any person showing evidence of any communicable skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharges, or any other communicable disease shall be denied admission.
2. Any person with excessive sunburn, open blisters, cuts, or bandages shall be denied admission.
3. Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any signs or symptoms of a gastrointestinal (stomach) disease in the past seven days.
4. All children in diapers must wear diapers specially designed for immersion in water (such as swimming diapers). Do not wash out soiled diapers in the bathing water.
5. Children should be encouraged to use the restroom before entering the water. Immediately report any "accidents" you observe in the bathing waters to a lifeguard.
6. No animals, except for service animals, shall be allowed in the swimming pool, wading pool, hot tub, or spa area, dressing rooms, or other parts of the enclosure.
7. Glass containers shall be prohibited in food and drink areas.
8. All persons shall shower before entering the water.
9. Conduct which endangers the safety and comfort of others shall be prohibited.
10. Outdoor bathing shall be prohibited during an electrical storm.
11. Persons suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol shall be prohibited from entering the water.
12. There is NO SMOKING in the pool area. Please check for designated smoking areas.
13. Please deposit all refuse in trash cans.
14. Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of their children. Lifeguards are not babysitters.
15. NO DIVING! There shall be no shoving or throwing of anyone into the pool. No stunt entries.
16. Swimmers shall leave the water immediately when told to do so by the guards, especially at closing time and during emergencies.
17. Management reserves the right to change the rules and regulations and evict for infractions.
18. Management reserves the right to close due to inclement weather, pool maintenance, or lack of staff availability.
19. Management assumes no responsibility for loss by fire, theft, accidents, etc.
20. Only employees are permitted in the pool houses. Please report any unattended tools or chemical containers to the staff.

POOL FLOAT POLICIES

Small inner tubes and swimmies are permitted in the Splash and 3 1/2 foot section of the Central pool as long as the child is within an ARM'S REACH of the parent or ADULT guardian. Please check pool house signage for examples of acceptable floatation devices. Inflatables are not to be left overnight in public areas. **Inflatables left overnight will be considered refuse.**

POOL TOY POLICIES

Balls and the projectiles are not permitted in the Central Pool. Soft and or squishy balls are permitted in the Splash Pool as long as they are not posing a danger or disruption to another patron. Enforcement shall be at the discretion of the staff members.

RULES FOR CHILDREN/ INFANTS REQUIRING SWIM DIAPERS

- CHILDREN AND INFANTS REQUIRING SWIMMING DIAPERS **MAY NOT BATH IN THE CENTRAL POOL.**
- SWIMMING DIAPERS ARE PERMITTED AND REQUIRED FOR NON POTTY TRAINED INFANTS AND CHILDREN IN THE LAKE AND SPLASH POOL. Do not wash out soiled diapers in the lake or pool.

1 BLAST = ATTENTION

2 CONSECUTIVE BLASTS = EVACUATION OF WATER

MISSING CHILD

- Report a missing child to a staff member immediately! Do not attempt to search for them yourself.
- In the event of a missing child, the pools and lake will be evacuated to begin a search and rescue operation. Road exits will be blocked to prevent abduction.
- Please cooperate with search procedure as instructed by lifeguards and management. You would want the same for your child!
